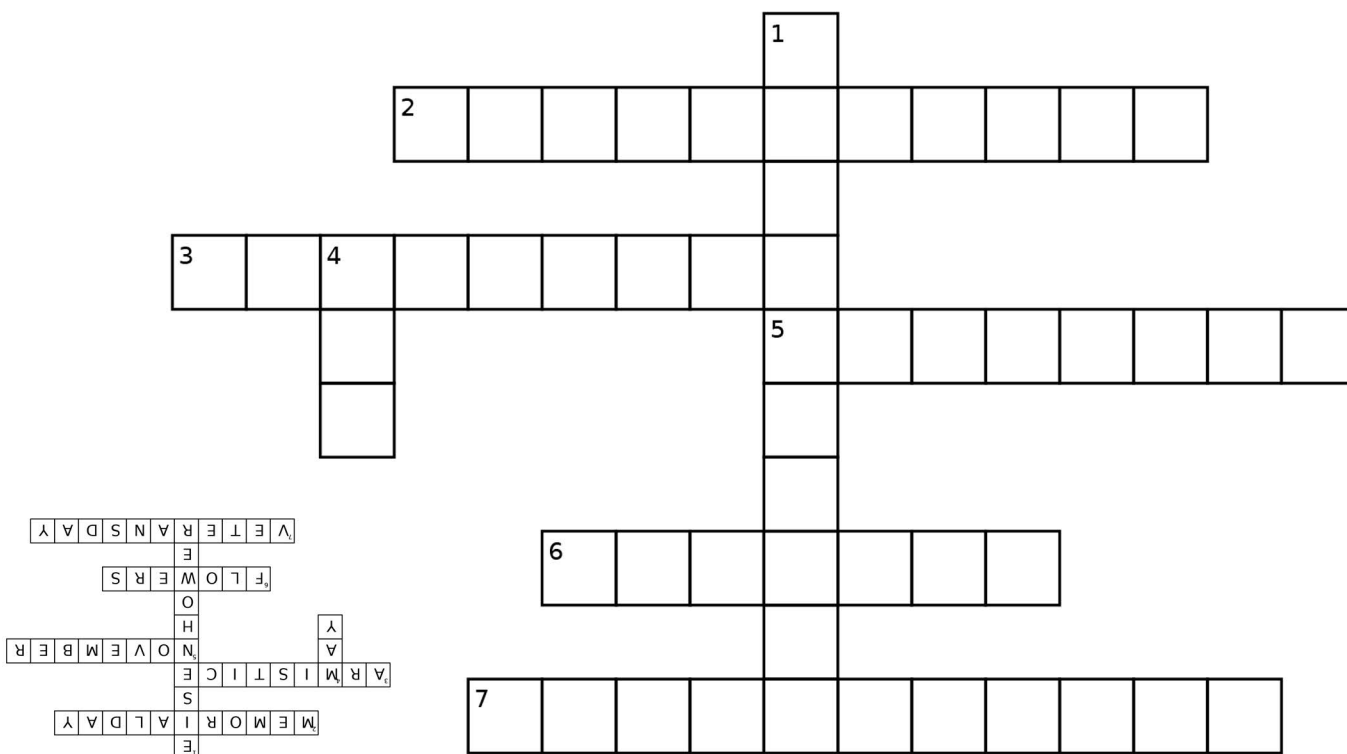


# Memorial Day & Veterans Day

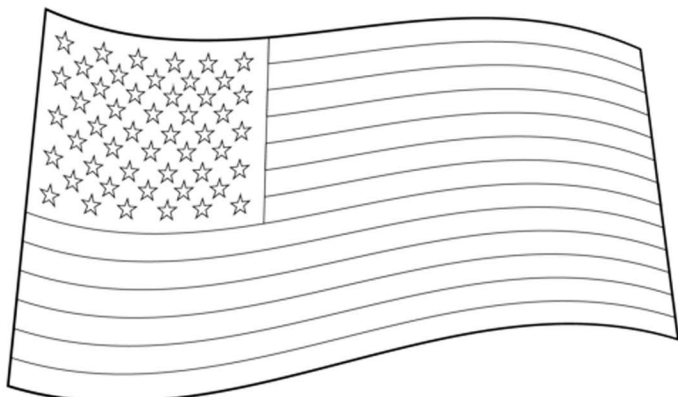


**Down:**

7. This holiday honors all who have served in the U.S. Armed Forces.



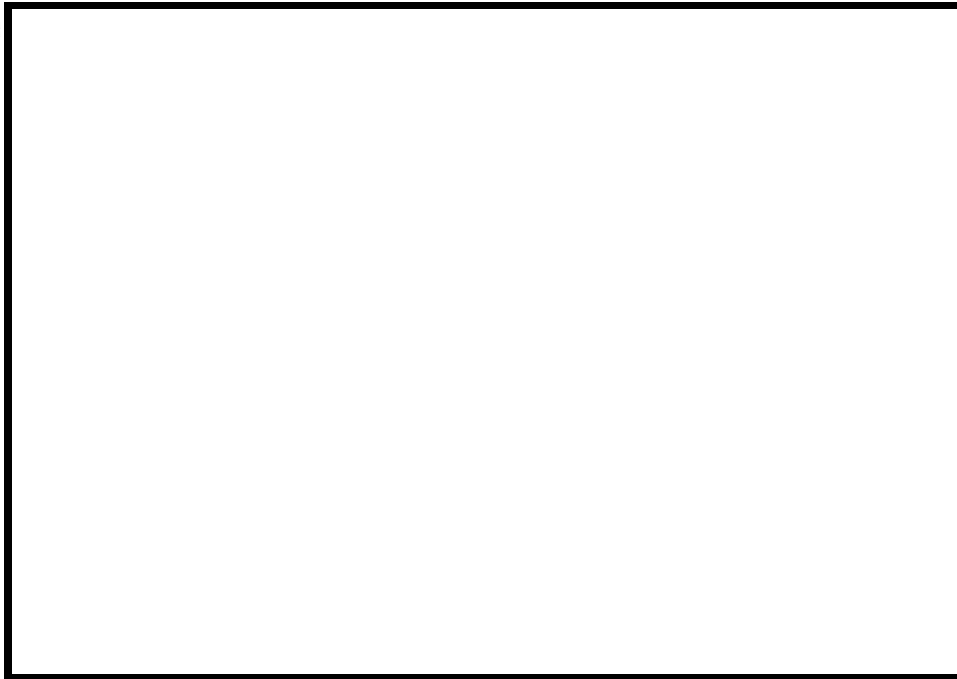
# our family's Summer Bucket List

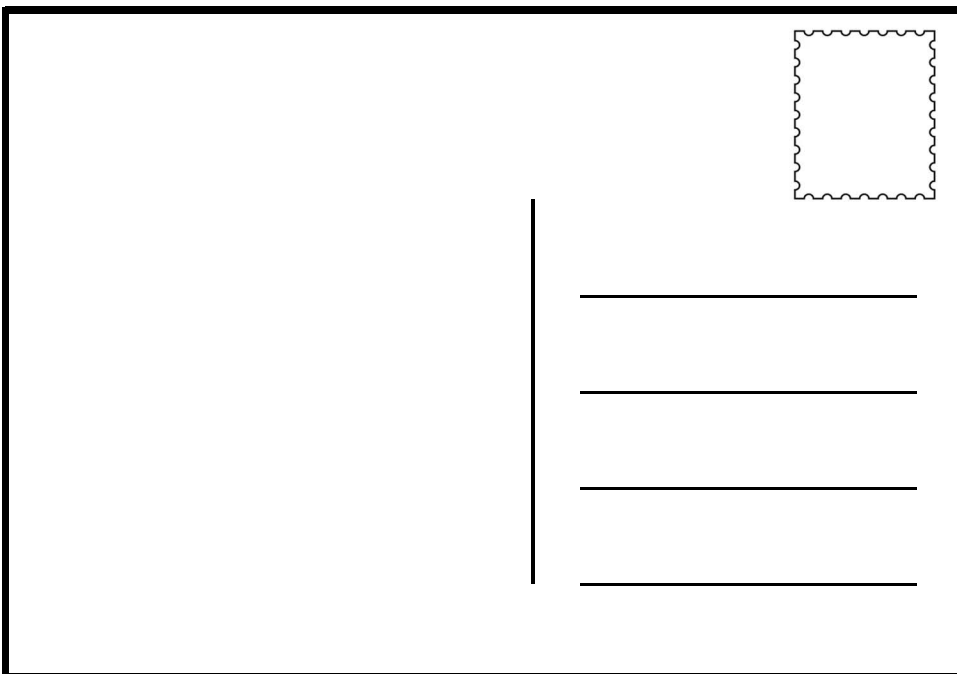
